2. SVG IN CONTEXT OF OECS



- 9 member states: seven
 (7) full members and two
 (2) associates. (SVG a full member).
- Six (6) member states in WTO.
- Goal: enhancing regional cooperation and harmonization.

Role of Trade Facilitation Task Force

- Provide policy guidance on:
 - Trade Facilitation Reform
 - Support the implementation of operational solutions
 - Formulate strategies in line with the national development strategy and international obligations.



5. TRADE FACILITATION IN SVG

Best Practice

Expedited Customs Clearance – The Gold Card Program (2013)

The Benefits

- 1. The Card Holder is recognised as a compliant client/stakeholder thus afforded the opportunity to have expressed clearance
- 2. Priority treatment of consignment if selected for examination.

The Benefits Cont'd

- 3. Favorably consideration to place of examination of commodity:
- 4. Establish a prepayment account to facilitate the timely and convenient payment of consignments.

8. CHALLENGES

- Weak legislative framework.
- Weak systems to facilitate electronic trade.
- High levels of physical and documentary examinations.
- Insufficient levels of coordination across agencies.
- Lack of full Task Force members in TFTF meetings.
- Lack of financial and technical resources to implement measures.

BENEFITS

- ★ Bottom –up approach
- Identification of and support to complementary agencies
- A more holistic approach that:
 - + Includes service linkages
 - + Is more about facilitation than compliance
- * Is more transnational in integrative processes
